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In 1952, Mr. Feuer came to Fairview. He taught biology and general science for five years, was a full-time counselor for four years and assistant principal for five years.

When asked to explain the difference in duties between assistant principal and principal, he replied, "Actually, there is very little difference. A principal has more contact with the teachers and the operation of the school itself. The assistant principal does a great majority of the mechanical functions of the schools operation."

Presently he is working on his Master's degree at Miami University and Xavier University.

Presently she is working on her Master's degree at Miami University and Xavier University.

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
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Mr. Norman Feuer, Principal, works closely with his Assistant, Mr. Ronald Bradley.

Mr. Bradley has been at Fairview for the past ten




Tom Phillips, senior, is of that rare breed of high school athletes — the golfer.

High school golf is not a spectator sport such as football and basketball, so most students do not know too much about it, but believe me when I say that Tom Phillips is a golfer par excellence.



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













































































