

The Fairview athletic department has finished one of its most successful years in the history of the school. The football team finished its season with one defeat but finished second in the City League with two games. Their total record was a strong 7-1-2.

The fencing team ended the season with a 7-5 record. Coach Don Barger's basketball team followed suit with the footballers and finished second in league play with 13 wins and 6 losses. The team was sparked by six graduating seniors.

The Fairview cross-country team finished 4th in the district compiling a 7 win, 2 loss record. Coach Eugene Winter's wrestling team ended its season in seventh place in the city.

Mr. Winters also led the Fairview gymnastics team to a 10th place finish at the state meet in Columbus. The Fairview track team

seniors were a great help in compiling the strong records our athletic teams achieved.

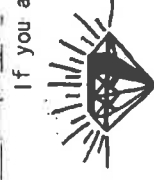
