

Historical Marker



A Memorial Historical Marker was erected in 1928 by the Miamisburg Alumni Association using a bell removed from an old Miamisburg school building. The monument's bell became an important part of the Association's tradition.

The Alumni Dinner and Dance was held in the Memorial Building and the bell was sounded and could be heard in the gym as the name of an alumnus who had passed was read.

In 1966 Alumni Association Dinner and Dance was moved from the the Memorial Building, the tradition continued with a hand bell being rung as names were read.

This tradition was changed again as a result of the large quantity of our alumni dying each year. Currently, a list of those who have passed is available for reading, then after a moment of silence--a bell from our old high school is rung.
